

Don't forget to collect your blister (tablet)

packs and ring-pulls for recycling in the various bins and pots at St Mary's! (FYI— you can take empty blister packs to be recycled at Boots in the chelmer retail park)

We are also collecting ring-pulls <u>(only from drinks cans—not food cans!)</u> for the charity "Purple Community Fund".

Each ring pull is worth 3p to the charity. PCF helps impoverished Filipino families living in the slums—the majority of whom earn a living from recycling the cities' waste collected from landfills. Through workshops and training programmes, they are taught how to make items such as ring-pulls into a range of eco-fashion accessories.
