A note from our Treasurer

Thank you all for your continued giving towards the work of the parish. At the last PCC meeting on 21st June, I presented this graph. I have been asked to share it with the wider church family.



It represents the actual income that the parish has received so far this year 2021. As you will see, in response to our appeal in January, we had a significant boost. Since then, the income has fallen. In order to reach the church's budget for 2021, (£84745) as of 21st June we needed to see our monthly income to rise to £7,000 per month for the rest of the year, from the start of July. Meeting this challenge will present an incredible opportunity to change lives for the better in our Parish. With God all things are possible! I would ask you to pray about this so that the life and work of the church is able to continue and thrive. If you aren't in the habit of giving regularly and would like to start to do so.
