Our congregations are represented by members of the Parochial Church Council. Here's what they discussed and agreed on your behalf in the October 21st meeting:

- for 6 months over the winter we will trial a community pantry outside the Parish Centre and then review how it's going. This will run alongside what we already do in relation to Fareshare and food vouchers.
- Our Parish Christmas card will be based on the candle painting by Zoe. A similar image on the candle theme was embellished by October Messy church.
- The new Café tables are in used and are available for other groups to use too.
- We'll soon be applying for a faculty for the accessible entrance at St Mary's.
- We will obtain a special box outside the Parish Centre to house the community bleed kit.
- Peter presented next year's budget for consideration by the PCC.
 The budget balances!
- The 5 yearly inspection of St Mary's was presented. We expect to do about £1600 of work next year and in the following years we will need to budget for substantially more maintenance and repair work.
- ◆ To help the Parish towards it's Net Zero and Eco church goals, subject to planning consent and supported by our architect, the PCC agreed that we should aim to install 37 solar panels (£18k)on the south facing walls. We may apply for grant funding and will also benefit from the Fowler legacy fund. The financial and eco benefit will be shared across CHS/STM. When installed they are intended to generate 2x as much electricity as we use at CHS/PC.

- We hope to replace the Parish centre lobby carpet in the spring aim to deep clean CHS carpet for the 1st time in 10+ years.
- ◆ The PCC agreed we should fund the cost of 25 bibles for persecuted Christians, and the opportunity to swell that figure was offered at the "If Prison walls could speak' theatrical presentation on 22nd October and can also be done through the collect (donation iin an envelope marked Bibles) no later than 3rd November please!
